

MotherToBaby Part-Time Paid Intern

This is a grant funded part-time paid internship that will also provide training in basic teratogen counseling.

Duties will involve assisting the Program Coordinator in running an efficient office and providing quality service to the public by:

- Triaging questions from the public and health professionals and providing education on the risks from various exposures during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- Researching medical literature and creating or updating statements on exposures as needed
- Creating and editing fact sheets and writing blogs for the National service
- Assisting in data entry and monthly reporting
- Supporting marketing and educational outreach efforts as needed

Qualification: An individual with a science background with an interest in women's health, prenatal care, maternal and child health or genetic counseling

Hours: 15-20 hrs. weekly, 3-4 days a week; hours are flexible
